Many personal developments of some players from 3rd world countries, such as Hamed Hadadi from Iran (plays now in N.B.A.), team in Jordan was a D-2 competition and coach Bosnjak brought for only 1 year in D-1 finals; One of the very few F.I.B.A. coaches who coached on 5 different continents and 5 different selections on F.I.B.A. competitions, while maintaining the Coaching Clinics experience. Beside great results that coach Bosnjak made with his teams he coached, most of the players moved to the next level. He maintained big Coaching Clinics and courses around the world, on 4 continents and in 5 countries. All topics he lectured include the newest things from modern basketball, such as, aggressive and transition game in defense and offense, aggressive traps vs. set up offenses, defensive systems with destruction of offensive games, as well as some topics with individual development of players on all positions in game. All topics were connected with rules in basketball with playing 24 seconds of offensive and how to adjust on those rules. Vladimir Bosnjak is one of the very few coaches who worked on 4 continents, Europe, USA, Asia and Africa.
